Dear All

For some time now a group of us have been seeking to set up a retreat centre within a suitable low RF area for electrically sensitive people to come and visit, holiday and recuperate.

Finally, we have found a location and are negotiating to take on a lease from the owners, which I would hope to complete by the end of this year. With some luck (and some support and funds) the centre may be able to be open fully in the middle of next year. There is a chance of opening earlier if we can resolve one or two issues.

There is no useable mobile phone network signal at the property. In order to keep unwanted RF exposures to a minimum, the centre will have a ban on all forms of RF and microwave generating equipment on site as well as computers and various other devices.

We intend to invite the trustees of ES-UK on 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> September and would welcome others who would consider supporting financially, or be interested in the role of house manager. The ideal candidate will be E.S (or very sympathetic to the E.S cause) but sufficiently robust to deal with the problems of E.S sufferers and manage the rigors of a 22 bedroom respite care centre, in return for board and lodgings at this stage.

We hope to call the new charity 'Electromagnetic Health Initiative' and have applied to become a charity in Scotland. The house is just over the border in southern Scotland.
